Updates on the progress of Orthodox Volunteer Corps



Here at the beginning of March, we are full of gratitude for all that is happening at OVC. Get a glimpse.

## Full-Time Program

We're pouring into Orthodox young adults—and the broader community—through our full-time service program. Our Corps Members are working at a free medical clinic, homeless shelters, after school programs, and a full-service community center. They are managing patient care, organizing volunteers, writing & delivering curricula, and tracking finances. They are meeting and staying close to their neighbors—translating for a refugee family that is learning the bus system; teaching a lesson to kids while right outside a man is being arrested; and visiting those without shelter in encampments, the hospital, and jail.



# Midyear Retreat



We held our Midyear Retreat at St Basil Academy in Garrison New York, reviewing the first five months, planning for the next five, and spending time in prayer & fellowship together. Huge thanks to National Philoptochos, who supported the retreat, to the staff of St Basil Academy for their overflowing hospitality, and to the OVC Corps Members who are living their faith day to day.

**A new part-time OVC offering for young adults in Pittsburgh**

In October, we launched a part-time program. Over 25 young adults have signed up for OVC Reach, which meets monthly at parishes in Pittsburgh for fellowship, faith formation, and service opportunities. We got things started by creating a list of volunteer events; now Corps Members are adding to the list through their parish and nonprofit connections.
