MOVING WITH KIDS

CORPS MEMBER SPOTLIGHT



How do kids practice healthy living if their street is too dangerous for play and their local grocer is a corner store stocked with candy? Ask Christina Lavin, a member of our 2024-25 OVC Cohort. She works at a neighborhood community health center in East Boston. Her program, Let's Get Movin,' combines creative exercise and healthy eating, including bringing a farmer's


market to compete with the corner store. Three girls she has come to know approached her during a recent market day, crestfallen that they had not brought the requisite forms to get food. Christina worked on the back end and quickly got the kids shopping. They raced back to her minutes later, "Look, Miss Christina, look at all these apples!"

MOVEMENT AT OVC

We continue to grow as an organization. Last year, it took two forms. First, we launched a new parttime program in Pittsburgh, OVC Reach, which enabled us to engage more young adults-five times more. We went from 6 participants in our first year to 30 last year. Second, thanks to all of you, we grew in contributions, receiving over 50% more than the previous year. Those donations enabled us to plan for more growth-most importantly our expansion to Boston this August. With two full-time programs running now, in Pittsburgh and Boston, we have twice as many full-time Corps Members.



ALUMNI ON THE MOVE



The dynamism of OVC is also evident in our alumni. Some are working full-time in Orthodox organizations-at the Neighborhood Resilience Project, Antiochian Village, and St Basil Academy. Others took front-line service positions-one at at homeless shelter, another at low-income housing development. Still others are linking their year of service to their career path-one alum who worked at a free medical clinic last year is now in medical school and was the featured student at her white coat ceremony; another who served at an after-school program last year is now a full-time elementary school teacher.

WHY WE MOVE



I am so excited to bring this experience back home with me and apply it to my personal life, my work as a teacher and to participate more as a lay person in my parish.

At OVC, we serve with purpose. Service is our calling-Christ commands us to act in mercy and humility, to wash feet and bind wounds. Service is a spiritual journey-we encounter Christ in the least of these our brothers and sisters. Service is community-by loving God and neighbor, we are the Church. As one alum, put it, OVC was not "another internship, volunteer experience, or job, but rather a holistic change in lifestyle and mindset within the context of service to the Church."

Thank you for another year with OVC. Thank you for your contributions, advice, and prayers. Thank you for helping this ministry thrive. Let's keep the momentum going. Let's keep movin'!
